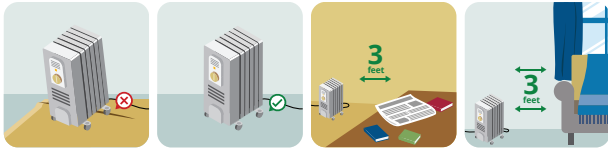


# Heater Fire Safety



Follow these heating safety tips to help keep your home fire safe this winter.

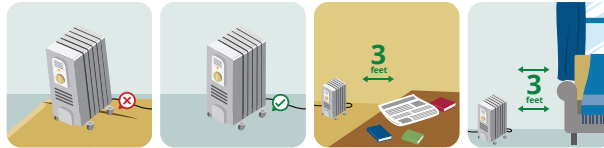


- ▶ Make sure your heater has been tested by a recognized testing laboratory.
