


Fire Department Overall Run Profile as Reported to the National Fire Incident Reporting System (2020)



In 2020, fire departments responded to 26,959,000 incident runs or calls as reported to the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS).

Of the reported runs, 17,297,200 (64%) required emergency medical services (EMS) and rescue services.

EMS-designated calls were, by far, the leading specific type of fire department run within the EMS and rescue service calls category (68%), followed by medical assists (14%).
