




Fire Department Overall Run Profile as Reported to the National Fire Incident Reporting System (2017)

Fire department calls by major incident type category (2017)



In 2017, fire departments responded to 26,880,800 incident calls that were reported to the National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS).



Of these reported calls, 17,308,300 (64%) required Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and rescue services.

EMS calls were, by far, the leading type of EMS and rescue service calls followed by medical assists.
